



Preparation Check List

The following list has been formulated to help ensure an inspection that provides the most ideal, most safe and most efficient conditions for a K9 search. If there are any questions or concerns, always feel free to reach out to our number (+1-917-994-2800) for all clarifications.

Prep list as follows:

- All pets should be removed from the inspection area or placed into a secure bathroom before the K9 team arrives
- All pet related items like bowls, toys, bedding, litter and food should be removed from the apartment or placed into the bathroom before the K9 team arrives
- All crumbs, debris, powders or fluids should be swept up, vacuumed and/or mopped before the K9 team arrives
- All medications, vitamins, pharmaceuticals and other drugs (pills, powders, etc.) are to be safely secured and out of reach of K9 before the K9 team arrives
- All bedding should be removed from bed and stripped down to mattress. Leave mattress encasements on if applicable. You can leave pillows as-is
- No cooking for 2 hours before the K9 team arrives
- If any bed bug sprays, lures, sticky-traps, powders or any other pest control chemicals like diatomaceous earth have been put down, they must be removed or we might not be able to inspect that area with the K9
- We must wait 30 days after the last treatment in order to inspect with the K9
- Do not use any strong smelling cleaners or fragrances (like bleach, alcohol, ammonia, essential oils, perfumes etc.) for 4 hours before the K9 team arrives
- No smoking 4 hours before the K9 team arrives
